- progress in the area of alternative technologies
- Recommendations
 - closed 17 (2006 and 2010)
 - leaves open 8
 - 3 new recommendations
- Continued coordination and communication

2014 Recommendations

- 3 new recommendations with regard to risk-significant sources address topics covering:
 - cybersecurity;
 - disposal/disposition financial planning; and
 - transition to effective alternative technologies

 - Implementation plans for the open and new recommendations
 - Lessons learned from the development process
 - Strategic planning for the next four years
